Prepare Your Neighborhood (PYN)

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

This is a grassroots program that focuses on neighbors helping neighbors prepare to meet any disaster that may occur. Training, coaching and mentoring support helps groups form neighborhood clusters in their area. Learn things such as:

- How to organize your neighbors to support each other in an emergency
- Basic emergency preparedness (go-bags, evacuation routes, family communication planning, etc.)
- How to set up a neighborhood gathering site

Go-Bags for Evacuation (Go-Bag Training)

It is critical that each person in a household has a Go-Bag at home, work/school and in each vehicle. Each bag would hold 3 days of survival supplies for emergencies. This training can be held in your neighborhood to help you get started on outfitting your personalized Go-Bags.

Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WaSH)

The coming earthquake and tsunami will destroy our water & sewer systems. No water at the tap, no flush toilets. This course teaches you how to find water, purify it, and store plenty of it safely. You will leave with a water filtration system, a simple hand wash station, and temporary toilets. You will have the know-how to use these materials to survive a disaster - if necessary, for months! You'll also learn how to reduce the spread of disease in a disaster.
